

All trees, vegetation, hedge-top line, ground line, sheds etc are accurate, extracted from a laser-surveyed 3D point cloud model.

Smallholder sheds, coops etc are to be removed.

Foreground trees block all view of the house from the south west and highway beyond.

In particular, the extended part of the recreated corrugated roof outshot range is invisible from the south garden and from the fields and highway beyond.

Smallholder sheds, coops etc are to be removed.

Their replacement with a single garden/store, of 15% their total footprint, sunk semi-underground, is minimally visible – only parts of its corrugated roof, and only from the south.

Foreground trees obscure view of the house from the south east

The raised lawn allows view of only the house's upper storey, only from south and south east, and only from within the garden.

From the fields beyond, the south hedge top (red dots) hides all but the roof apexes and chimneys. From the highway, just one chimney is visible.

The visibility and impact of the proposed Listed Buildings alterations on the surroundings will be negligible from within the garden and zero from the fields and highway beyond.
